

WaterSure Scheme

(previously the Vulnerable Household Scheme)



WaterSure

If you have a low-income, WaterSure could help. The scheme puts a limit on your charges for water and sewerage services, as long as you meet the following criteria:

- 1. You have a water meter
- 2. The bill payer or someone else in your household receives benefits (please see the next page for a list of which benefits qualify) or tax credit

and

- 3. There are either:
 - a) you or someone living in your household has a medical condition that means they use a lot of extra water; or
 - b) You or someone living in your household is receiving child benefit for 3 or more children under the age of 19.

This year, the reduced amount you would pay on the WaterSure scheme is:

£176 for water and £157 for sewerage charges for the period 1 April 2014 to 31 March 2015

If your current charges are higher than this, you may be entitled to pay the reduced charge. Once on the WaterSure scheme, if your actual metered bill is lower than the reduced charge, we'll simply charge you the lowest amount.



Please note: 1. You do not qualify for WaterSure if you water your garden with a non-handheld appliance such as a sprinkler or domestic irrigation system or if you have an auto-fill swimming pool or pond with a capacity of over 10,000 litres. 2. You do not qualify if you have a commercial property, i.e. small holding, shared accommodation, farm or nursing home.
